

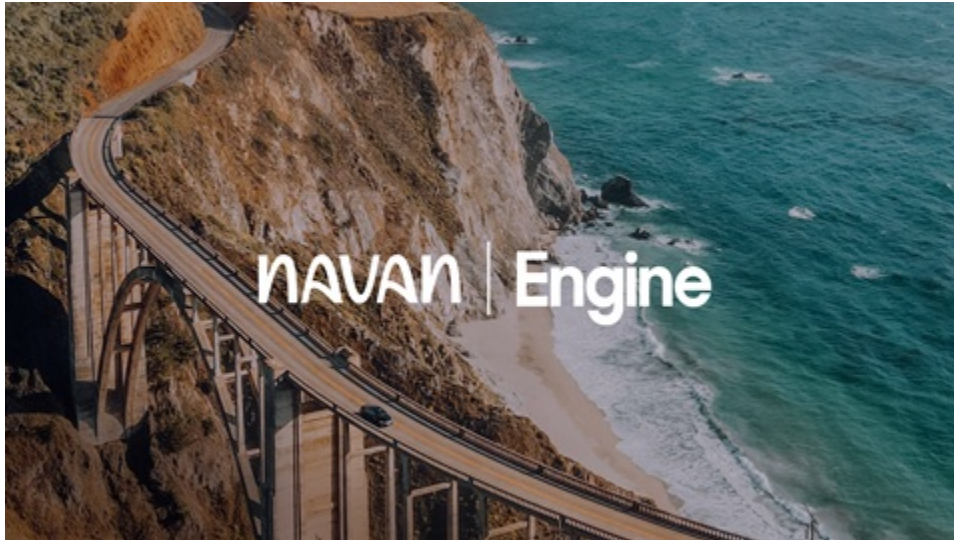


Navan and Engine Announce Strategic Technology Partnership to Power New Capabilities in Business Travel
